

## **MEDICAL INFORMATION**

Participants coming from any state or Nation with identified disease or trending outbreak must provide clear medical certificate of being free from such disease or must provide evidence of immunization against such.

No immunization requirement in Nigeria, however, candidates coming from area (s) with trending public health issues are usually assessed and investigated before being admitted to Nigeria.

Candidates with special needs; in terms of medical management must be reported to the FAAN Medical Unit for proper assessment and advice before class commences or first day in class.

Special diet e.g vegetarian candidates should be communicated to be handled by the catering unit ahead of arrival or on day 1 of course.

Medical indemnity insurance or life insurance may be undertaken by the candidate in his state and transferred to us as evidence for medical care.

NOTE: FAAN Training School has capability to respond to emergencies and sick students/participants as follows:

1. A within facility sick-bay and two FAAN clinics/hospital
2. Port health services care for communicable diseases
3. A military hospital within 3minutes Drive/20minutes walk
4. A sate General Hospital is within 15minutes drive
