### Visa requirements

Passport **MUST** be valid for at least six (6) Months after the intended date of departure. Passport must have at least one blank page for entry stamp. Passengers who also require a visa must have a passport with two blank facing pages, one for the visa and one for their entry stamp. Anyone attempting to enter Nigeria without the required pages will be returned to their country of origin.

Visa On Arrival (VOA) is issued at the port of entry in Nigeria.

### Health information

FAAN has a Clinic that operates 24hrs service and the capability to respond to any emergency.

### Health requirement

A yellow fever certificate is required from all travellers over one year of age from infected areas. There are no requirements for any inoculations to visit Nigeria

Participants coming from any state or Nation with identified disease or trending outbreak must provide clear medical certificate of being free from such disease or must provide evidence of immunization against such.

No Immunization requirement in Nigeria. However, candidates coming from area(s) with trending public health issues are usually assessed and investigated before being admitted to Nigeria.

Special diet e.g. Vegetarian candidates should be communicated to be handled by the catering unit ahead of arrival or on day 1 of course.

Medical indemnity insurance may be undertaken by the candidate in his/her state and transferred to us as evidence for medical care.

### Cell/Mobile phone systems

Airtel, Glo, MTN and 9mobile are the network cell phone systems available. There are sim local shops available in arrival hall of the terminal at Murtala Muhammed Int'l airport where you can purchase sim cards for your phone.

### Electricity and plugs

220v- is obtainable in Nigeria. Participants are advised to come with regulated adaptor





### Weather

There are two main seasons namely:- Wet and Dry seasons. The wet season occurs mainly between the months of April – October while the Dry season occurs between November to March.

Lagos State Temperature: Lagos has about 21 to 31 degrees Celsius in January. The average weather in October is about 26.35 degrees Celsius. Afternoons can be very hot with average temperature reaching 30 degrees Celsius. Night temperatures are generally warm with average low of 22.4 degrees Celsius.

### Lagos main tourist attractions

**Beach:** The state where the school is situated has lot of beaches: Takwa Bay Beach is one of the small island located along the Atlantic coast. It is an artificial island created during the construction of the Lagos Harbour. Eleko Beach is a scenic beach in the [city of Lagos](#) located along 56 km, Lekki-Epe Expressway Lagos. It is a private beach which offers a serene retreat from the everyday hassle of a city lifestyle. It is perfect for time out with friends, personal getaway or great time with kids. And the Beach is located not too far from the famous [La Campagne Tropicana](#). Coconut Beach at Badagry: Aptly named for its Coconut trees, this is a favorite beach in the coastal town of Badagry. The beach is located about 20 miles towards the border of Nigeria and the Republic of Benin. It is a great place to visit. There are other beaches.

**Lekki Conservative Centre:** So, Lekki Conservation Centre, (LCC) is a 78 hectare (or 190 acres) Natural Resource Conservation, which is situated in Lekki, Lagos State. It was established in 1990 to serve as a biodiversity conservation and environmental education centre. The vast 190 acres has typical savannah and swamp habitats of the Lekki demi-island. Also, it has plenty of animal species that can be easily seen from the raised canopy walkway. A lot of endangered species like maxwell's duikers, monitor lizards, birds, crocodiles, bush bucks, snakes, monkeys, etc and others are taken care of in this wonderful zone. Talking about the Lekki Conservation Centre canopy walk which is the longest in Africa, it is considered to be one of the best ways to feel closer to nature and relax. This area has large wetlands, which are set sideways for the wildlife. If you pay this place a visit, it gives you the strongest experience of nature. So make a move, you will surely get a memorable experience

**Badagry Slave Trade:** The state is privilege to have and to preserve its heritage. Badagry was an important slave route in West Africa during the Slave Trade era. The ancient town of Badagry was



founded in 1425 AD. Before its existence, people live along the coast of Gberefu, now known as the town of Badagry. It is a great place to visit.

**National Art Museum:** Established in 1957 in Onikan Lagos, the Museum has great collections in archaeology, ethnography and traditional art display contemporary arts and historical monuments. The main attractions at the museum are the galleries dedicated to bronzes from Benin City, Nok Terracottas etc. Another gallery dedicated to traditional symbols of power, contains carved ivory and a royal host of crowns. The museum houses the bullet-riddled car in which the country's former Head of State – late General Murtala Mohammed – was assassinated in a failed military coup on 13<sup>th</sup> February, 1976. It also operates a nonprofit crafts centre, which stocks a good range of batik cloth, woodcarvings and textiles at fixed prices. There's a fine range of intricately decorated calabashes from across Nigeria. The National Museum Lagos has a small crafts village with woodcarvings and other handicrafts for sale at fixed prices; you might also see a demonstration of adire – cloth-making from Abeokuta.
