NOTICE OF INTENTION TO IMPLEMENT SANCTIONS ON OUTSTANDING DEBT DUE TO THE FEDERAL AIRPORTS AUTHORITY OF NIGERIA

The Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FAAN) hereby serves notice to all Government Agencies and Private Airport Operators who are indebted to the Authority that Management is giving a 30 Days grace period effective Monday 9th September, 2019 for them to settle all outstanding debts.

The Authority shall be constrained to commence the implementation of sanctions at the expiration of this notice if the concerned organisation fail or refuse to pay up, as advised.

In view of the above, the Authority hereby notifies private operators that the services of our Aviation Security and Airport Fire and Rescue personnel will no longer be available for the operation of their airports with effect from Wednesday 9th October, 2019 as the Authority can no longer keep these personnel at the working without payment.
